






DOCTORS ARE GENERALLY A HAPPY GROUP OUTSIDE OF WORK.







### OPHTHALMOLOGISTS TEND TO IDENTIFY AS BEING MORE EXTROVERTED.







## HOW MANY CLOSE FRIENDSHIPS DO PHYSICIANS HAVE?
